

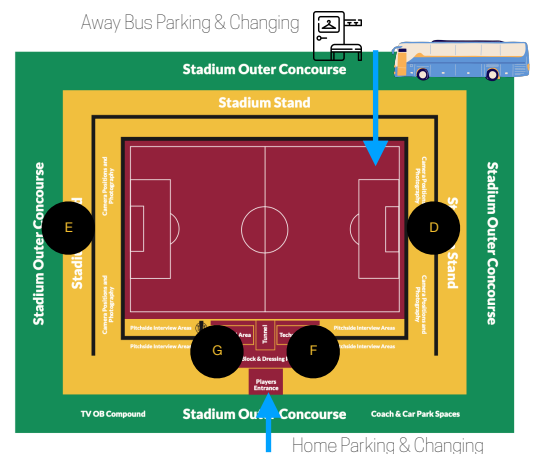


## BERWICK RANGERS FOOTBALL CLUB

### Player & Match Day Officials Guidance for Shielfield Park.

- Players & Officials are to arrive at the ground between no less that 90mins prior to kick off.
- Home team players are to make their way through the main club entrance (see appendix).
- Away team will arrive at gate 7 (see appendix and supporting video). The team bus can park within the stadium at gate 7 and players will disembark and head to their changing facilities (as outlined below).
- Match day officials will arrive through the same entrance as the home team. And will have their own changing space in the main building (see supporting video).
- Please wear a mask and maintain social distancing when arriving at the ground. Players must have completed the COVID test before leaving to come to the stadium and temperature checks will be conducted upon arrival. The visiting team are responsible for taking and maintaining their own temperature records.
- Once the visiting team are ready, they can make their way to the pitch as highlighted by the arrow to the right (see supporting video for specifics). Substitutes and club officials are going to be seated in the main stand, Block G. Please make your way across the pitch towards the tunnel and take your seat in the block, as directed by stewards, whilst maintaining social distancing.
- The home team officials and substitutes will take their seat in the main stand in block F, turning right once coming from the home dressing room.
- The stadium is split into 3 zones, Red, Amber and Green. Only players, coaches, officials should enter the red zone.

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- Players must bring with them a mask and their own water bottle for use on the day.
- Substitutes must not enter the red zone unless they are becoming an active member of the on-field team. Substitute warm ups can take place in Amber zones. The dedicated warm up areas are marked 'D' (home team) and 'E' (away team).
- Each team will leave out of the same entrance/exit they arrived.

Area Map:



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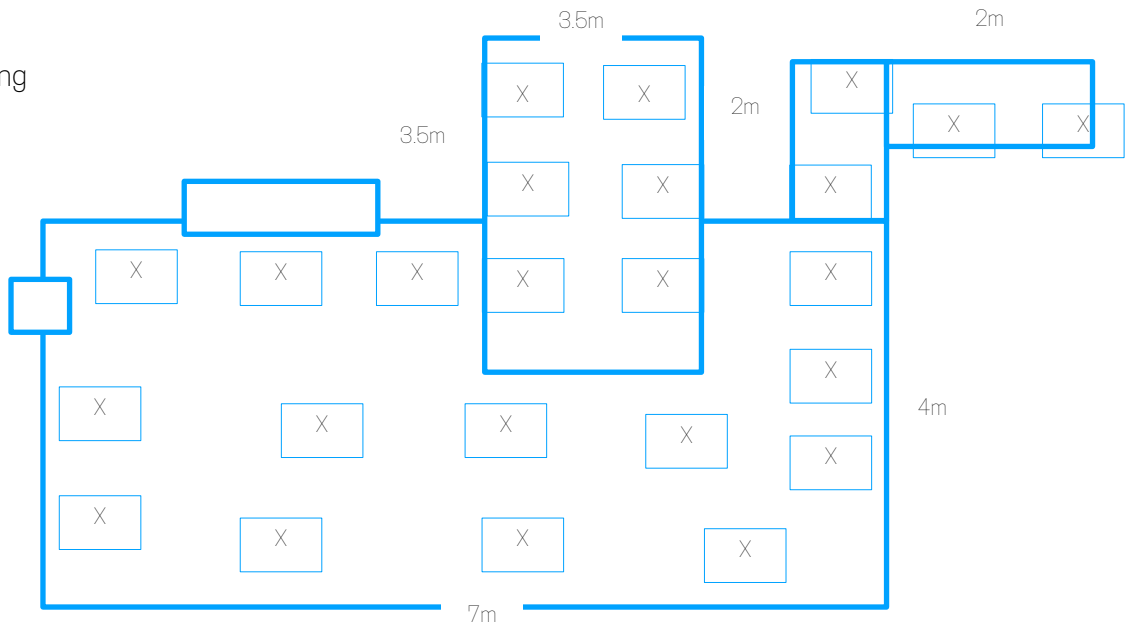

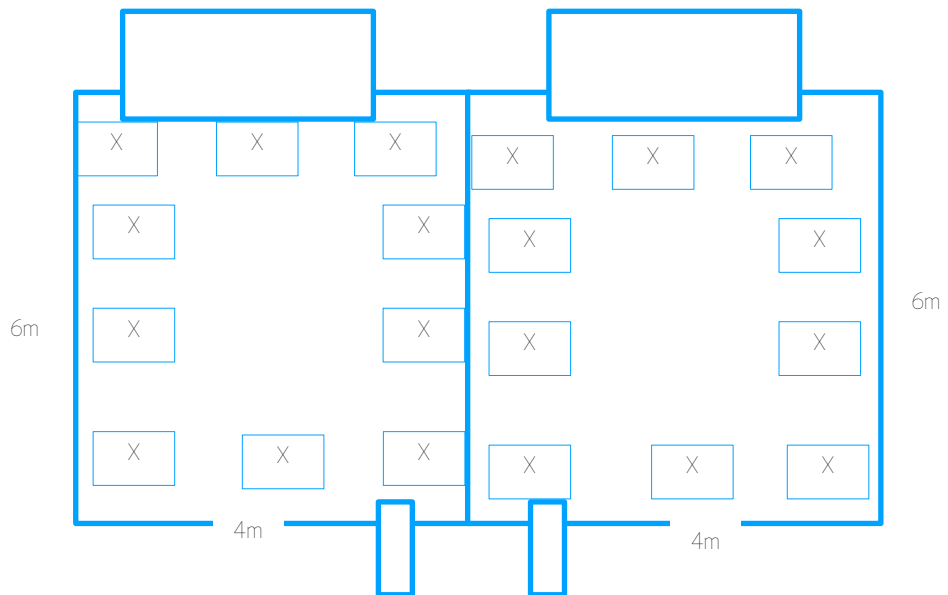
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Home Changing



Away Changing:



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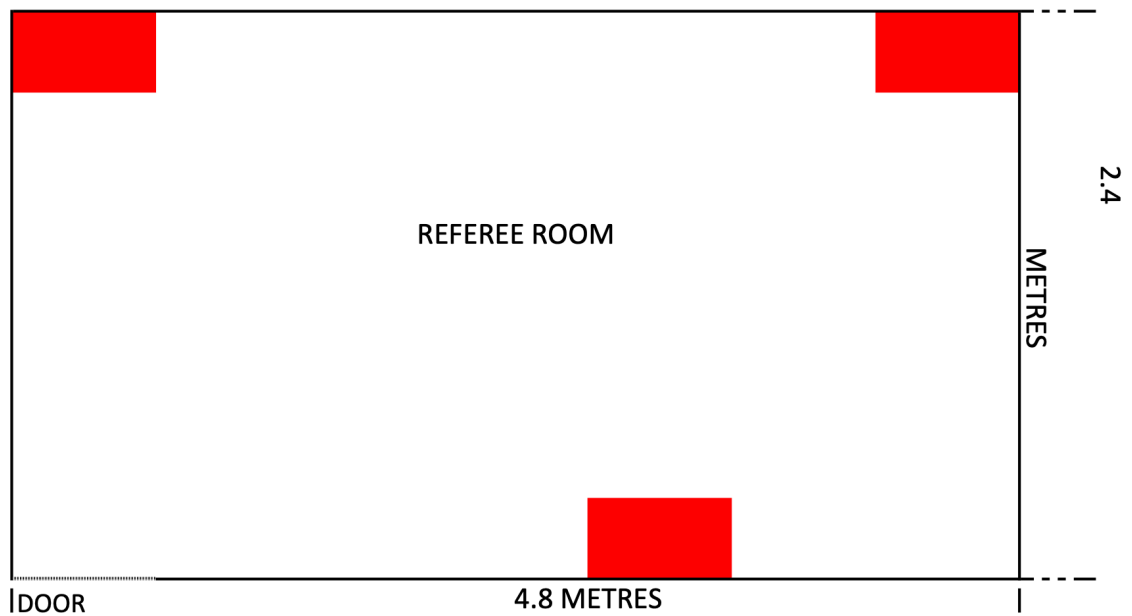
